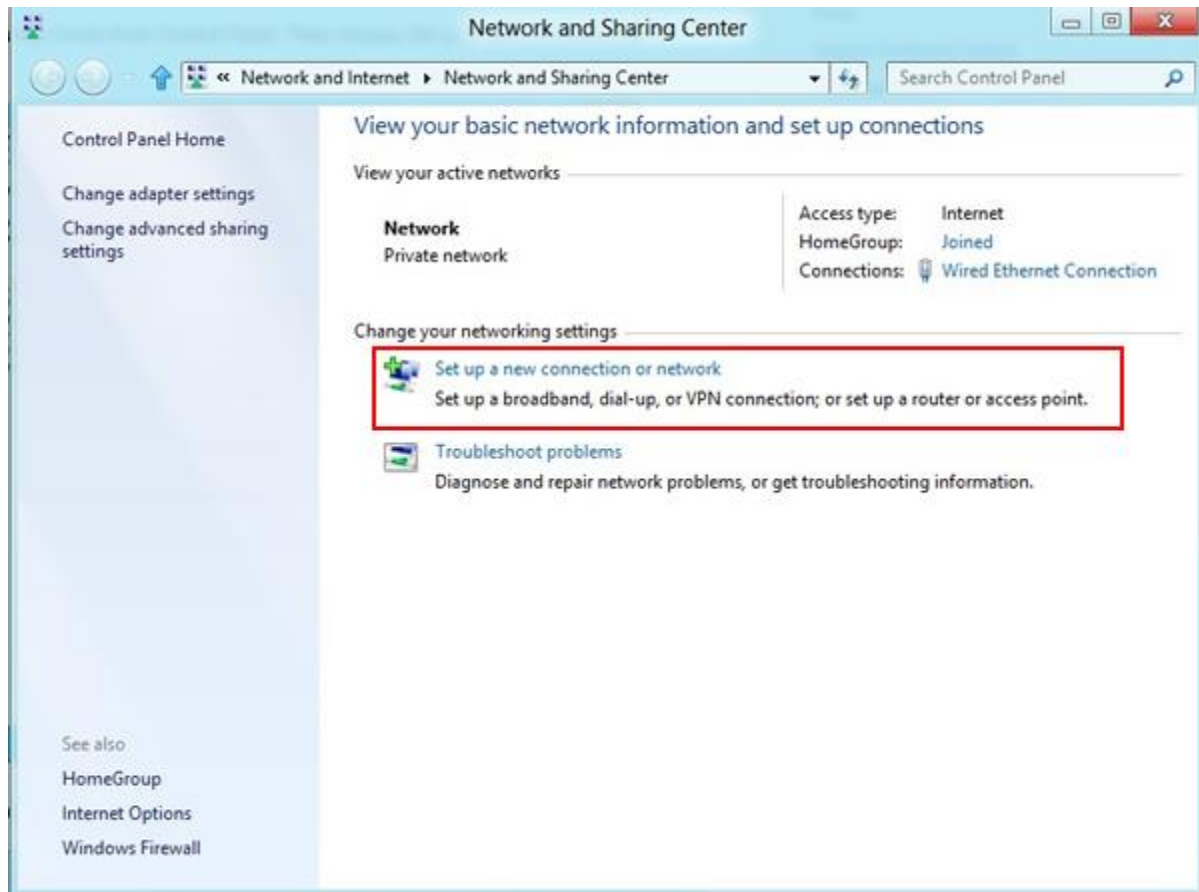
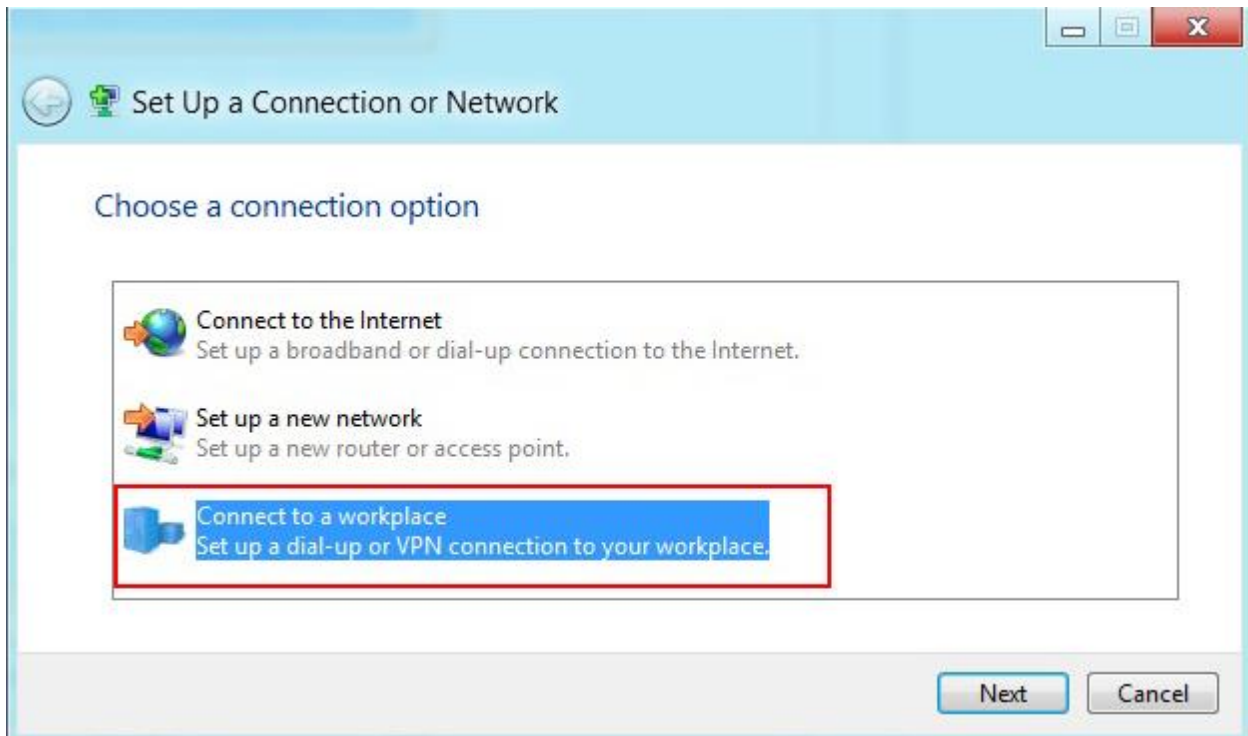


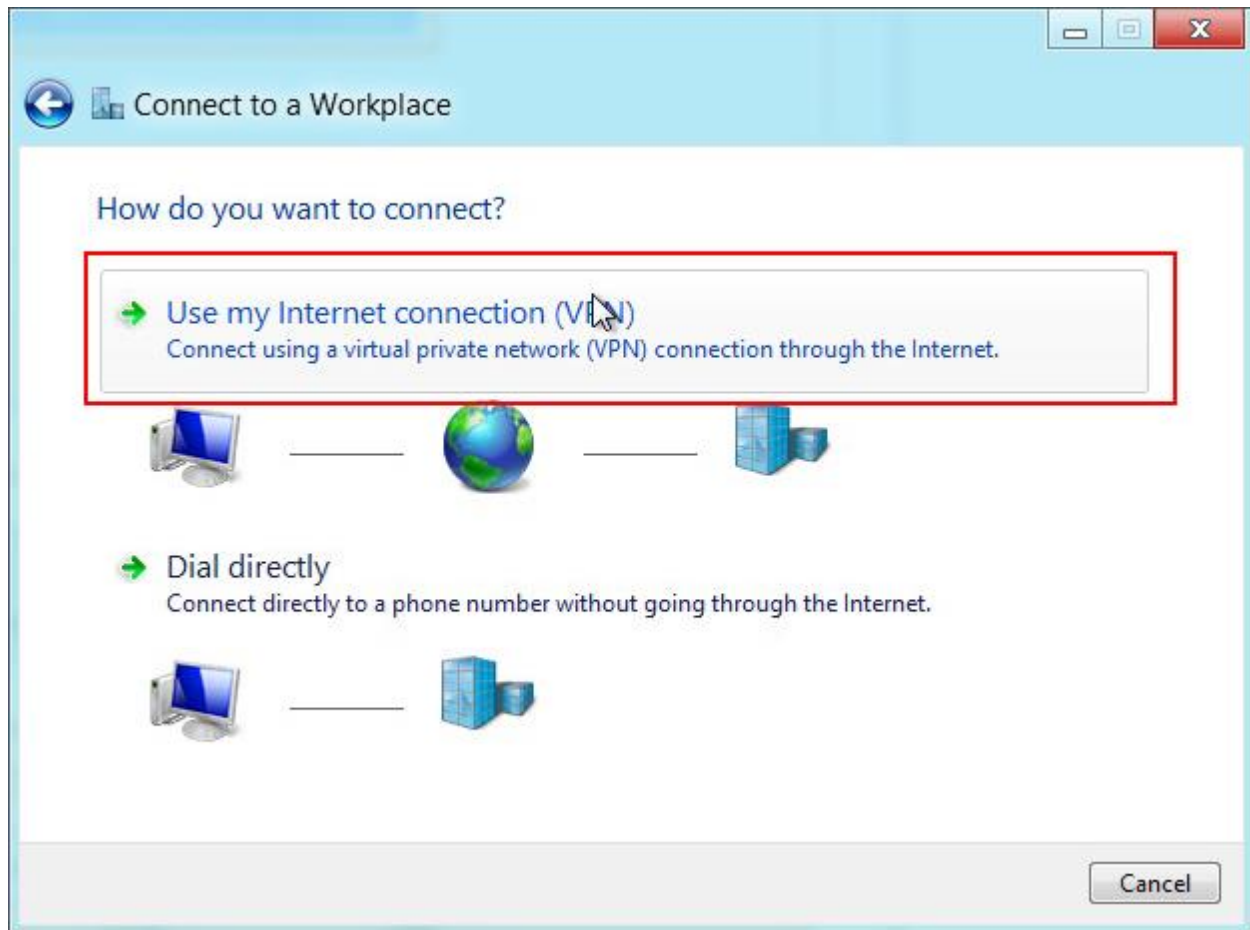
STEP 1 - Open Network and Sharing Center from Control Panel. Then choose Set up a new connection or network.



STEP 2 - In the next window, choose: Connect to a workplace and click Next.



Step 3 -In the next window, choose Use my Internet Connection (VPN).



Step 4 - Now, enter the server information. click to see more important information

In the text box labeled 'Internet address' type vpn.aucegypt.edu

In the text box labeled 'Destination name' give it a name such as [AUC-VPN](#). This is the name of the connection, and will show up in the "Connect to a network" screen when we're done.

Make sure that the checkbox labeled "Don't connect now; just set it up so I can connect later" is checked.

You can also put a check at "allow other people to use this connection"

Then click the "Next" button.

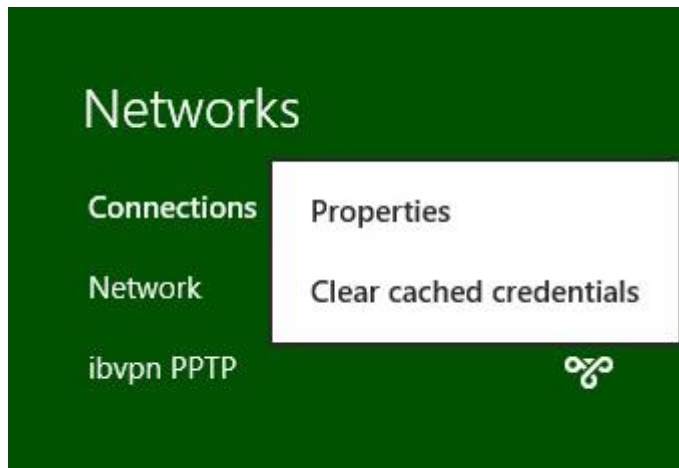

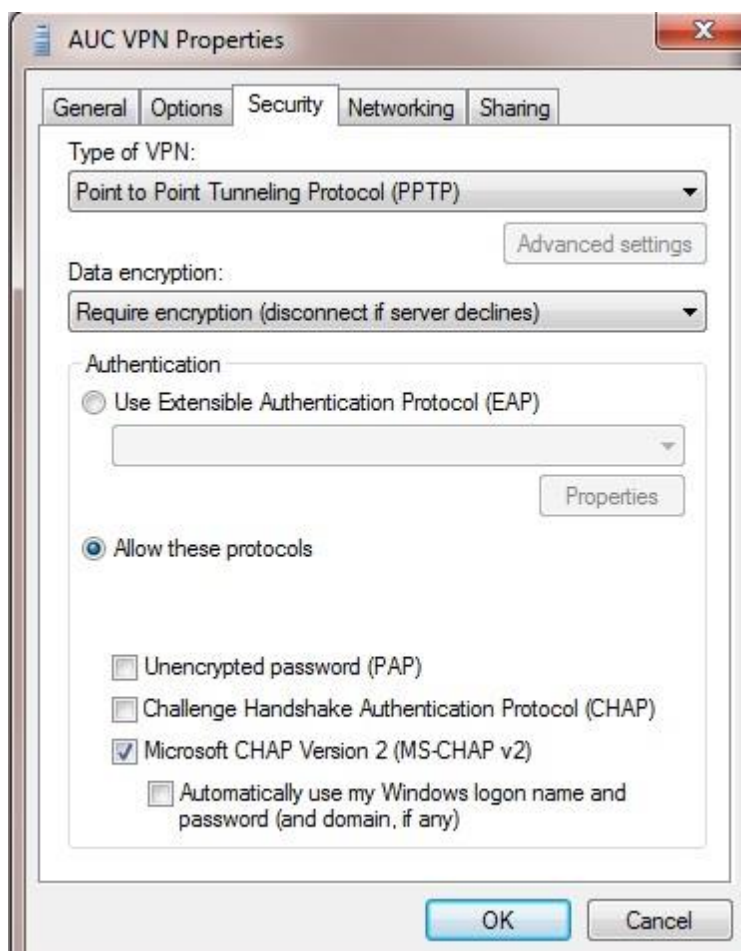

Step 5 - Click on the monitor icon on the bottom right-hand corner. Right-click on the **AUC-VPN connection, and choose Properties from the menu.**



Step 6 - Under Security Tab for Type of VPN select "Point to Point Tunneling Protocol (PPTP)" and click OK.



Step 7 - Almost done, Click again on the monitor icon on the bottom right-hand corner, find **AUC-VPN connection and click connect. Type your VPN username and password and click OK.**
