

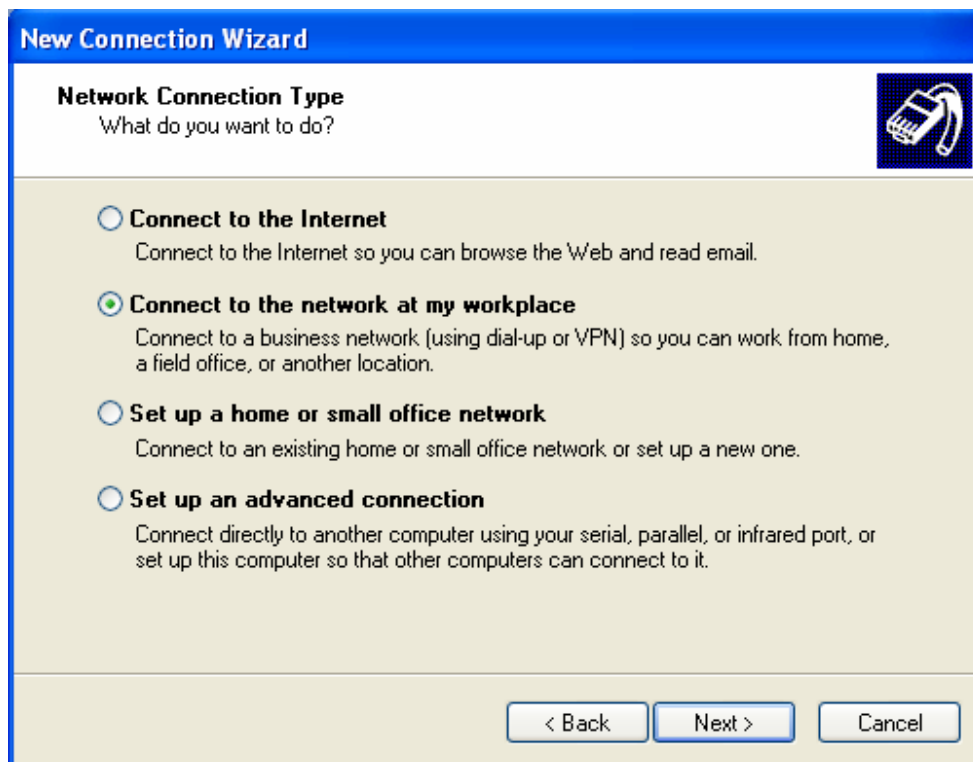
# VPN Setup Guide on Windows XP

## 1 - Setting up Connection

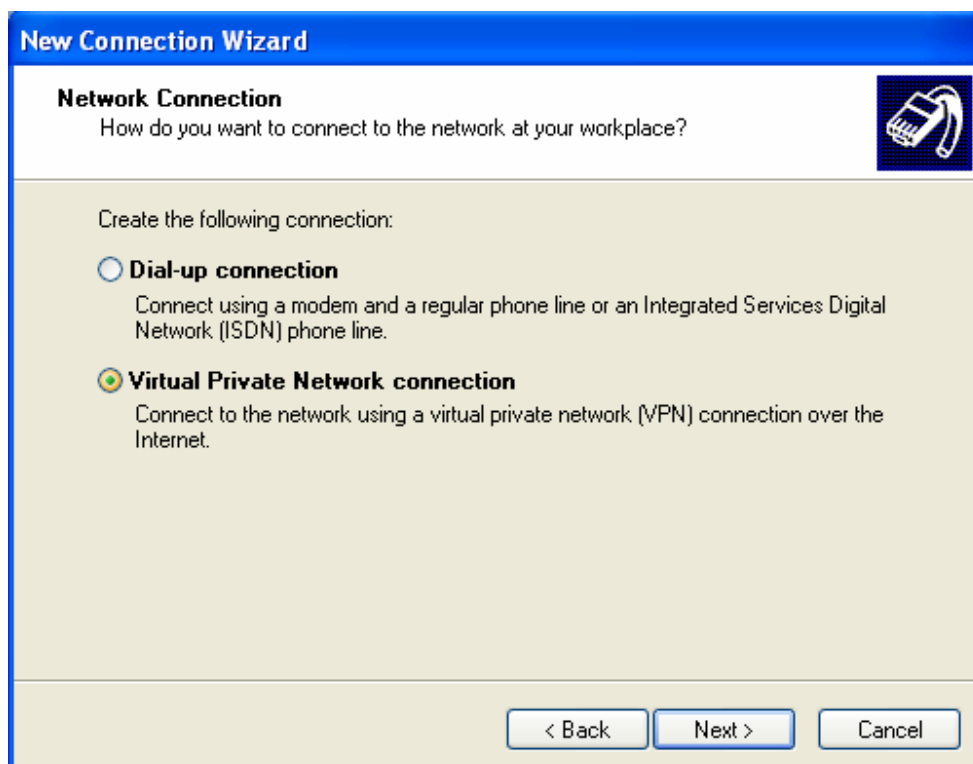
1. Click on **Start Menu**, then **Control Panel**
2. In the Control Panel, select **Network Connections**, and then select **Create a new connection**, the following installation wizard window will appear. Click on **Next**




3. Select **Connect to the network at my workplace**, then click on **Next**



4. Select **Virtual Private Network connection**, then click on **Next**



5. In the *Company Name* field, type in *AUC-VPN* or any other name you prefer to describe this connection, then click **Next**

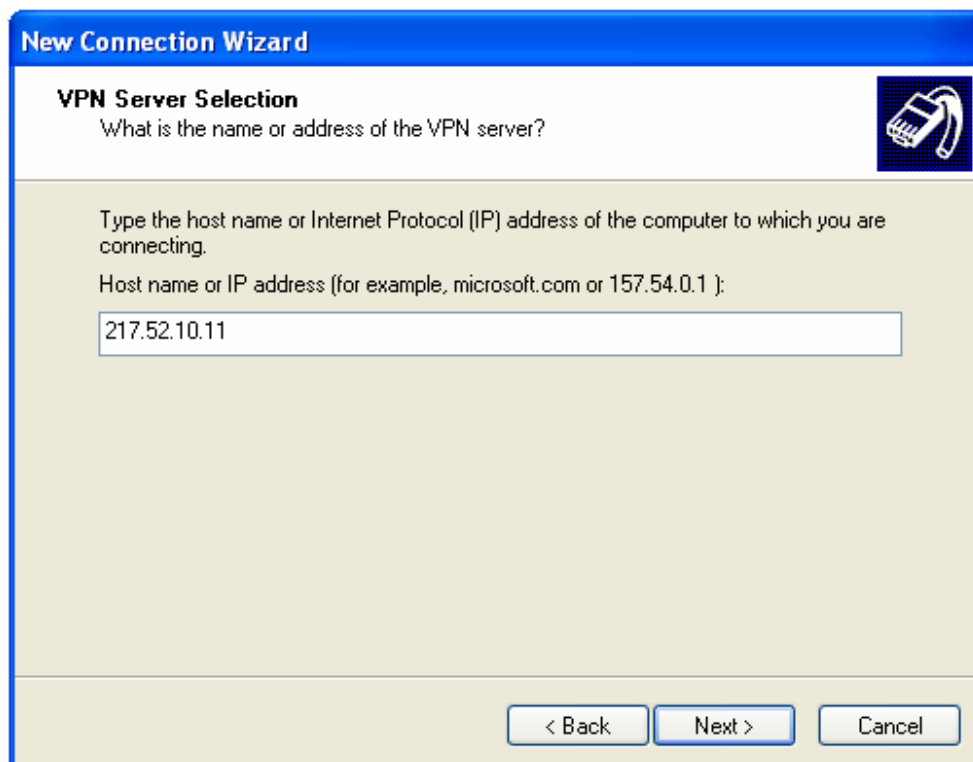

6. Select **Do not dial the initial connection**, then **Next**



7. In the *Hostname or IP address* field, type in the IP Address **217.52.10.11**



8. You have now completed the VPN Setup. Click on **Finish**

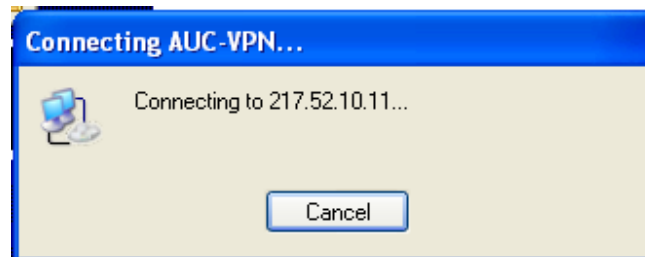


## 2 - Connecting through the VPN connection

1. Click on the **Start Menu**, go to **Connect To**, then select *AUC-VPN* or whatever name you specified for the connection.
2. Type in your username and password in the specified fields, then click **Connect**



3. The username and password will be validated.



4. After successfully getting connected to AUC VPN server, you will be able to access AUC resources *according to the privileges given to your account.*
